



Brown: How much rain fell in the months of July and August combined?

Red: How much more rain fell in May than in June?

Green: $4.25 \times 2 =$

| Month | Rainfall (in cm) |
|-----------|------------------|
| May | 8.5 |
| June | 6.25 |
| July | 4.3 |
| August | 7 |
| September | 6.45 |

Green: Miguel is buying Halloween candy for his favorite teachers. He bought 4 bags of candy that cost a total of \$7.12. How much did each bag of candy cost?

Green: The manager for the JBMS football team has 5.15 gallons of Gatorade for football practice. If there are 20 people on the football team, how much Gatorade does each person get? (Round to the nearest hundredth)
